

Summer Reading Report 2023

Summer Reading has wrapped up in the Palliser library region, and it had a massive impact on Saskatchewan residents! Each library branch hosted their own programs, and tailored their approach to the patrons in their communities. Some branches hosted weekly events, some hosted a handful of events throughout the summer, and others provided online programs or take-home kits throughout the summer months. Many of our branches experienced a significant increase in their summer programming this year, and over **9850 people** benefitted from summer programming across the Palliser region!

In an attempt to showcase the immense impact that our summer reading programs have on literacy in the region, we asked each branch to record the total minutes that their patrons read over the summer months as a result of their programs. Due to the diversity of programming, we offered two methods of recording: paper reading logs and the Reader Zone app. As a result of Palliser's programs, patrons read a reported total of **649,481 minutes!**

In addition to recording reading, Palliser headquarters also provided branches with a "Summer Reading Toolkit", which included optional pre-made materials for their programs. Our theme this year was "Mysteries and Capers". Materials included promotional materials, activity printables, literacy activity calendars, and paper reading logs. We also hosted an online meeting with branches to allow for collaboration and sharing of ideas.

This year, we received a lot of positive feedback about the pre-made materials Palliser headquarters provided, as well as the communication and training our branch staff received. Staff also shared some excellent ideas which we hope to implement in the future!

In this report, we have compiled all the reported statistics in the region, and then provided a section for each branch's statistics and descriptions of their programs this year. We are so proud of our branch staff, and all the hard work they put in to encourage literacy and connection in their communities, and we are honored to share their reports with you.

We did a huge basket of adult prizes for them to enter their name in (everyone gets a prize).

Our program was run in conjunction with play patrol so there was outside time, gym time, and craft activities for 50 hours for the summer.

We received funding from the Bethune Recreation Board to run Summer Reading and Play Ptrol. We also
received funding from our school council for the prizes for the kids.
